

European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)

The European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) previously known as the E111 card, allows you access to the same healthcare that residents of that individual country have.



EHIC is valid in all European Economic Area (EEA) countries including Switzerland and allows access to state provided healthcare, at a reduced cost or sometimes free of charge.

REMEMBER!

It is important to remember that The EHIC is NOT an alternative to Travel Insurance. It will not cover any private medical healthcare or the cost of other things like mountain rescue, or the cost of getting you back home! It also doesn't cover lost or stolen property.
